## **2010 Youth Award Series Requirements**

1. Youth must be a member of EPRHA. Points will begin accumulating from the date membership is purchased.
2. In order to be eligible for year end Youth Series awards a minimum of 20 points will need to be accumulated.
3. Point Sheets will need to be signed and dated prior to being accepted by EPRHA Youth Coordinator.
4. NRHA show attendance- For each NRHA class that you ride in you will receive 1 pt.
5. If you are volunteering or doing community service and your hours can be used for more than one organization you will need to designate which hours are for EPRHA. Example you volunteer 6 hours running the gate at a horse show and you are a member of EPRHA and RMRHA, you would need to decide how many hours would go towards EPRHA and how many would go to RMRHA. This will eliminate the double dipping affect, where you would be getting credit for all 6 hours for both organizations.
6. Depending on Fundraisers in 2010, your points may be based on time worked or items sold, Youth Coordinator will help determine this as each fundraiser is established. Only EPRHA fundraiser hours will be counted.
7. Additional requirements can be determined as new question arise, but will be addressed to all youth currently earning points prior to being accepted as a requirement.
