8. ELIMINATION. Unless otherwise specified, Elimination means that the Athlete/Horse combination in question may not continue to participate in the current Event.

a. Technical Elimination: Any elimination may be recorded as a ~~TE (technical elimination)~~ Technical Elimination (TE) if the fault is ~~a rider or Athlete error, (i.e. omission of obstacle, third error of course in dressage, or missing start or finish flags), and not directly caused directly or indirectly by the horse's disobedience, weak, or aberrant performance.~~ at the discretion of the Ground Jury (i.e. omission of obstacle, third error of course in dressage, or missing start or finish flags).
